

ORDINANCE NO. 1018, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE SUPPLIES ON THE OPEN MARKET, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, WHERE, AFTER DUE ADVERTISEMENT, NO PROPER BIDS WERE RECEIVED FOR FURNISHING THE SAME; AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

WHEREAS, pursuant to specifications adopted by the City Council, the City Clerk duly advertised for the purchase of 400 Tons, more or less, of Liquid Asphalt, and no bids were received by said Council which corresponded to specifications.

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market

200 TONS, MORE OR LESS, GRADE NO. 5
MEDIUM CURING LIQUID ASPHALT

300 TONS, MORE OR LESS, 200-300 PENETRATION
PAVING ASPHALT.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being for the reason that the above supplies are necessary for the immediate use of the Engineering Department of the City of Sacramento.
