### SUMMARY:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a revocable encroachment permit for the purpose of  
documenting existing alley improvements.

is hereby granted to OPPORTUNITIES FOR HANDICAPPED, INC., whose  
address is as follows: 3340 Marysville Boulevard, Sacramento, CA 95838.

The encroachment area is described as follows:

An area of an alley adjacent to City address 3340 Marysville Boulevard. An area 13 feet by 100 feet in the public alley running east of Marysville Boulevard as shown on the plat of Eleven Oaks. The improvements were installed under Building Permit No. I-1707 and consist of asphalt pavement, sidewalk, curbing and landscaping.

This permit is granted subject to the "General Provisions - Revocable Encroachment Permit", which were adopted by the City Council in Resolution No. 81-845 dated November 17, 1981, and the hereinafter specified special conditions, if any. This permit shall be effective only after the applicant files with the Risk Management & Insurance Division of the City of Sacramento, the insurance certificates required by the General Provisions.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Permittee shall comply with all conditions of Building Permit No. I-1707.
2. Alley shall remain open and free of obstruction.
3. Traffic through alley shall not be obstructed, and no permanent parking shall be allowed.
