

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-466

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSULTANT AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DOWLING ASSOCIATES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$171,019 FOR PREPARATION OF A TRAFFIC STUDY FOR THE DOWNTOWN RAILYARDS PROJECT

BACKGROUND:

- A. The City of Sacramento has selected Dowling Associates to prepare a traffic study for the proposed Downtown Railyards Project and proposed development, and
- B. Dowling Associates is on the existing Master Services Agreement list for traffic studies maintained by Development Engineering Division of the Development Services Department.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into a professional services agreement in the amount of \$171,019 with Dowling Associates to provide preparation of the traffic study for the Downtown Railyards Project.
