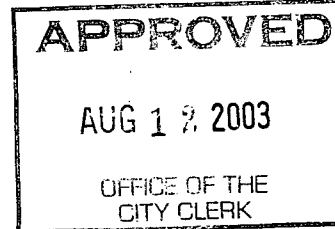

**SUBJECT: 24th STREET & IRVIN WAY / 26TH AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT
(PN: SM10) - APPROVE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPT BID, AND
AWARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO TIM PAXIN'S PACIFIC
EXCAVATION, INC.**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

24th Street & Irvin Way / 26th Avenue in Council District 5 (see location map – Attachment A).

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends the City Council adopt the attached resolution:

- Approving the plans and specifications;
- Accepting low bid of Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation, Inc., in the amount of \$178,205; and
- Authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract for the 24th Street & Irvin Way / 26th Avenue Traffic Signal Project (PN: SM10).

SUMMARY:

This project involves the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of 24th Street & Irvin Way / 26th Avenue. In addition, new curb ramps will be installed at these intersections.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION: None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The 24th Street & Irvin Way / 26th Avenue intersection currently does not have a traffic signal or pedestrian crossing. This project was the number one ranked traffic signal in the 2002 Transportation Programming Guide. The installation of the signal will enhance the movement of traffic and provide a safe crossing for pedestrians.

The project has been advertised for bids and the following bids were received on July 2, 2003:

Tennyson Electric	\$310,681	20.3%

The engineer's construction estimate was \$220,000. It is recommended that the contract be awarded to Tim Paxin's Pacific Excavation, Inc, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Construction is expected to start August 2003 and be completed December 2003.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The 24th Street and Irvin Way / 26th Avenue Traffic Signal Project (PN: SM10) total project budget is \$381,000 (Fund 201). As of July 22, 2003, the unobligated balance is \$333,300, which is sufficient to award the construction contract in the amount of \$178,205 (Fund 201) with Tim Paxin's Pacific Ecavation, Inc.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Planning and Building Department, Environmental Services Section, has determined that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 (b) and Section 15303 (d). A Notice of Exemption has been filed with the County Recorder's Office.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3 and with the City of Sacramento's Strategic Plan goal of enhancing and preserving neighborhoods.


ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:

To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to ESBE construction firms. Staff actively recruited available ESBE firms to participate in the bid process. The project was also announced on the City's Project Information Line and Internet site at www.cityofsacramento.org/bids. The recommended contractor includes certified ESBE participation of 100%

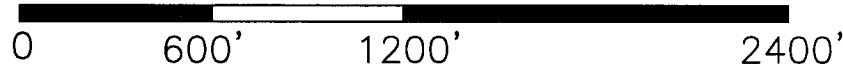
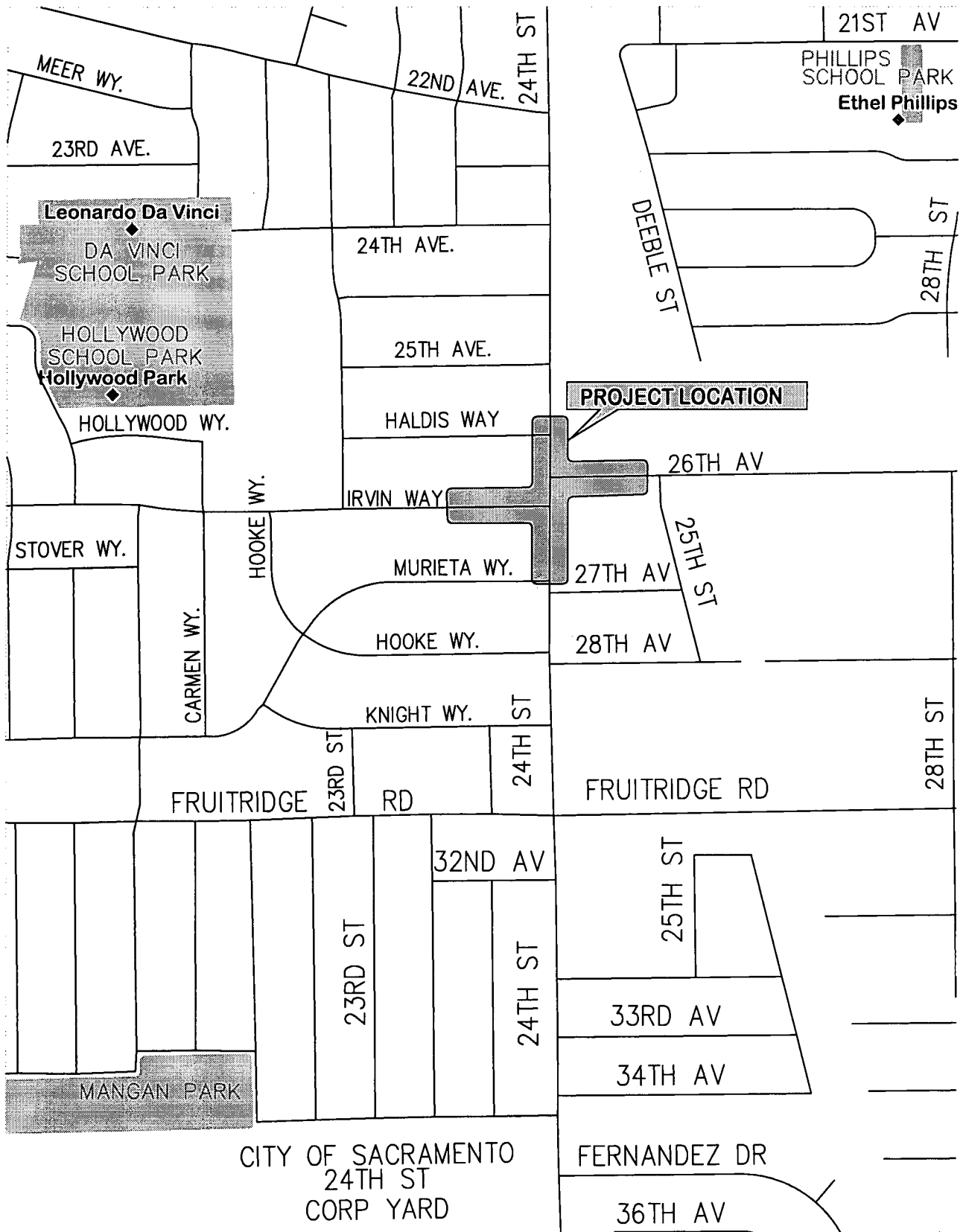
