WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento welcomes the opportunity to establish and foster economic relationships with the cities in the Philippines and in particular with the City of Iligan; and


WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento seeks to foster the enhancement of international human and civil rights for all people irrespective of race, religion, gender, or sexual orientation; and

WHEREAS, trade relations create and contribute to a positive economic impact for the City of Sacramento as well as Iligan City, Philippines.


