BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Grades as shown on said Plans be, and the same are, hereby adopted as the official Grades; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Specifications herewith submitted by the City Engineer for special types of work not included in the City of Sacramento's "Standard Specifications" be, and the same are, hereby approved and adopted.

Resolution of Intention No. 2686

Pursuant to a law of the State of California, known as Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, the Improvement Act of 1911."

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

7TH AVENUE from the center line of 58th Street to the westerly line of Lot 6 GEORGE ELLEN TRACT (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder), by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks; installing cast-iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; constructing a concrete manhole complete with cast-iron curb and cover; installing vitrified ironstone pipe sewer; installing street monuments; constructing one Water Distribution System Complete; grading and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches in thickness.

All of said work to be done in accordance with the "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers" heretofore adopted by the City Council and also in accordance with detailed Plans made therefore by the City Engineer and on file in his office having been approved by the City Council on April 30 th, 1948.

Cast-iron gutter drains shall conform to Cut #11 of said Specifications.

Concrete curbs and gutters shall conform to Cut #13 of said Specifications.

Manhole cover shall conform to Cut 1B of said Specifications.

Sewer Joints shall be made with G-K Sewer Joint Compound as specified in Section 13 of said Specifications.

Water Mains shall be in accordance with Standard Specifications for the installation of Water Mains, Fittings, Valves, Fire Hydrants, and Appurtenances of the Water Department of the City of Sacramento, heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Sacramento.

Asphaltic concrete pavement shall be constructed as provided in Section 29 of said Specifications.
