

ORDINANCE NO. 1450, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The following streets at present named in the City of Sacramento are hereby changed to the following names which shall, in the future, identify said streets and shall be recognized as the official names thereof, to-wit:

Plumas Avenue to 50th Street,  
Mariposa Avenue to 52nd Street,  
Ventura Avenue to 54th Street,  
Dakota to 56th Street,  
Berkshire to 57th Street,  
Carly Avenue to 67th Street,  
Brier Avenue to 15th Avenue,  
Ahlstrom Way to 15th Avenue,  
15th Avenue to 16th Avenue  
(60th St. to 62nd St.)  
Santa Rosa Avenue to 17th Avenue,  
Santa Maria Avenue to 19th Avenue,  
Sonoma Avenue to 51st Street,  
San Benito Avenue to 53rd Street,  
Solano Avenue to 55th Street,  
Glenn Avenue to 63rd Street,  
Peltier Avenue to 65th Street,  
Anderson Avenue to 69th Street,  
Herbert Avenue to 71st Street,  
Eighteenth Avenue to 17th Avenue,  
(58th St. to 60th St.)  
Santa Ana Avenue to 18th Avenue,  
Santa Barbara Avenue to 20th Avenue.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that an order for street signs is being held up pending the approval of the change in street names as provided herein.
