

RESOLUTION No. 695

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of  
October 29, 1948

WHEREAS, on May 28, 1948, the CITY OF SACRAMENTO entered into an agreement with W. E. REARDON and JOHN C. KNEILLY granting to them the exclusive privilege of operating the hat check and soft drink concessions at the Municipal Auditorium; and

WHEREAS, since the execution of that agreement one of the partners, W. E. REARDON, has passed on and the surviving partner, JOHN C. KNEILLY, desires to continue under the terms and conditions in his own name; and

WHEREAS, it further appears that satisfactory arrangements have been made by the surviving partner with the widow of said deceased partner for a division of the partnership assets, including the interest in the concessions and the right to continue,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the agreement heretofore entered into under the partnership above mentioned be continued under the name of JOHN C. KNEILLY as surviving partner, and that all of the terms and conditions of said agreement shall continue, and that the surviving partner shall make arrangements to substitute his name on the bond, insurance and other papers covered as provided by the agreement.
