SUBJECT: Mechanical and Electrical Upgrades for City of Sacramento Storm Sump 157 - Amendment No. 1 to Consultant Services Agreement to (City Agreement No. 87186)

SUMMARY

It is recommended that the City Manager be authorized to approve Amendment No. 1, in the amount of \$1,600.00 to the Consultant Services Agreement with Metcalf & Eddy, Inc. for the Mechanical and Electrical Upgrades for City of Sacramento Storm Sump 157.

BACKGROUND

Presented for approval is Amendment No. 1 to City Agreement No. 87186 with Metcalf & Eddy, Inc. for design services for upgrading the City of Sacramento Storm Sump 157 located at the north end of Western Avenue. This amendment provides for an increase in consulting fees of \$1,600.00.

Additionally, the scope of work shall include the following services:

1. Design layout of pad mount transformer area in accordance with Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) regulations and requirements.
2. Perform conduit and wire calculations as appropriate for the electrical service for Storm Sump 157.
3. Incorporate the above requirements into the electrical single line diagram design for the Mechanical and Electrical Upgrades for Storm Sump 157.


FINANCIAL



Exhibit A - Scope of Work

Metcalf & Eddy, Inc. (Consultant) under this agreement will perform design work required by the Sacramento Municipal Utility District (SMUD) for moving the Sump 157 transformers from their overhead position to a pad on grade.

The Consultant's scope of work shall include:

1. Design layout of pad mount transformer area in accordance with SMUD regulations and requirements.
2. Perform conduit and wire calculations as appropriate for the electrical service for Storm Sump 157.
3. Incorporate the above requirements into the electrical single line diagram design for the Mechanical and Electrical Upgrades for Storm Sump 157.

The Consultant shall include this work in the "Plans and Specifications" for the project.

Exhibit B - Fee Schedule/Manner of Payment

The fee for services described in Exhibit A of this amendment is not to exceed one thousand six-hundred dollars (\$1,600.00). The Consultant will be paid on a monthly basis for work performed under this agreement. The Consultant shall submit monthly statements of fees and expenses, and payment by the City shall be made within thirty days after receipt of statements.
