

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE
CITY OF SACRAMENTO
APPROVING THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
FOR EXPENDITURE OF
1/4 CENT GAS TAX ALLOCATED FOR STATE HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, The State of California, through its Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, has presented a memorandum of agreement in accordance with a project statement submitted by the City for expenditure of the 1/4 cent gas tax for the 1941-43 biennium allocated for State Highways in the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard read said agreement in full and is familiar with the contents thereof;

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that said agreement for expenditure of the 1/4 cent gas tax allocated for State Highways be and the same is hereby approved, and the City Manager and the City Engineer are directed to sign the same on behalf of said City.
