SUMMARY

Bids were received from nine (9) contractors and opened by the City Clerk on July 28, 1999. The lowest responsive bidder was Navajo Pipelines with a bid of \$144,390. Navajo Pipelines met the Emerging and Small Business Enterprise (ESBE) goals. It is therefore proposed to award the contract to Navajo Pipelines for \$144,390.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project consists of installing approximately 1,000 linear feet of 8-inch diameter water main in Bercut Drive. Handicap ramps exist at the street corners within the project limits and therefore are not required as a part of this project. This project was advertised and bids were received on July 28, 1999, and are summarized below:

* M & S Pipe Lines was the apparent low bidder but their bid was deemed non-responsive and rejected because the bid did not include the required bid bond.

- The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$137,500
- The estimated completion date is October 1999.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The total project cost including design, construction, inspection and contingency is \$168,000 based on the bid of \$144,390. As of August 4, 1999, the unobligated balance available for this project (413-500-ZB31-XXXX) is \$253,996, which is sufficient for award. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funds will reimburse the City of Sacramento for damages caused by 1997 storm waters in the amount of \$54,468.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

The Planning Services Division, Environmental Section, has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is categorically exempt from CEQA under Section 21080.21 of the CEQA Guidelines.

The responsive low bidder, Navajo Pipelines, exceeded the ESBE goals with a participation level of 100%.



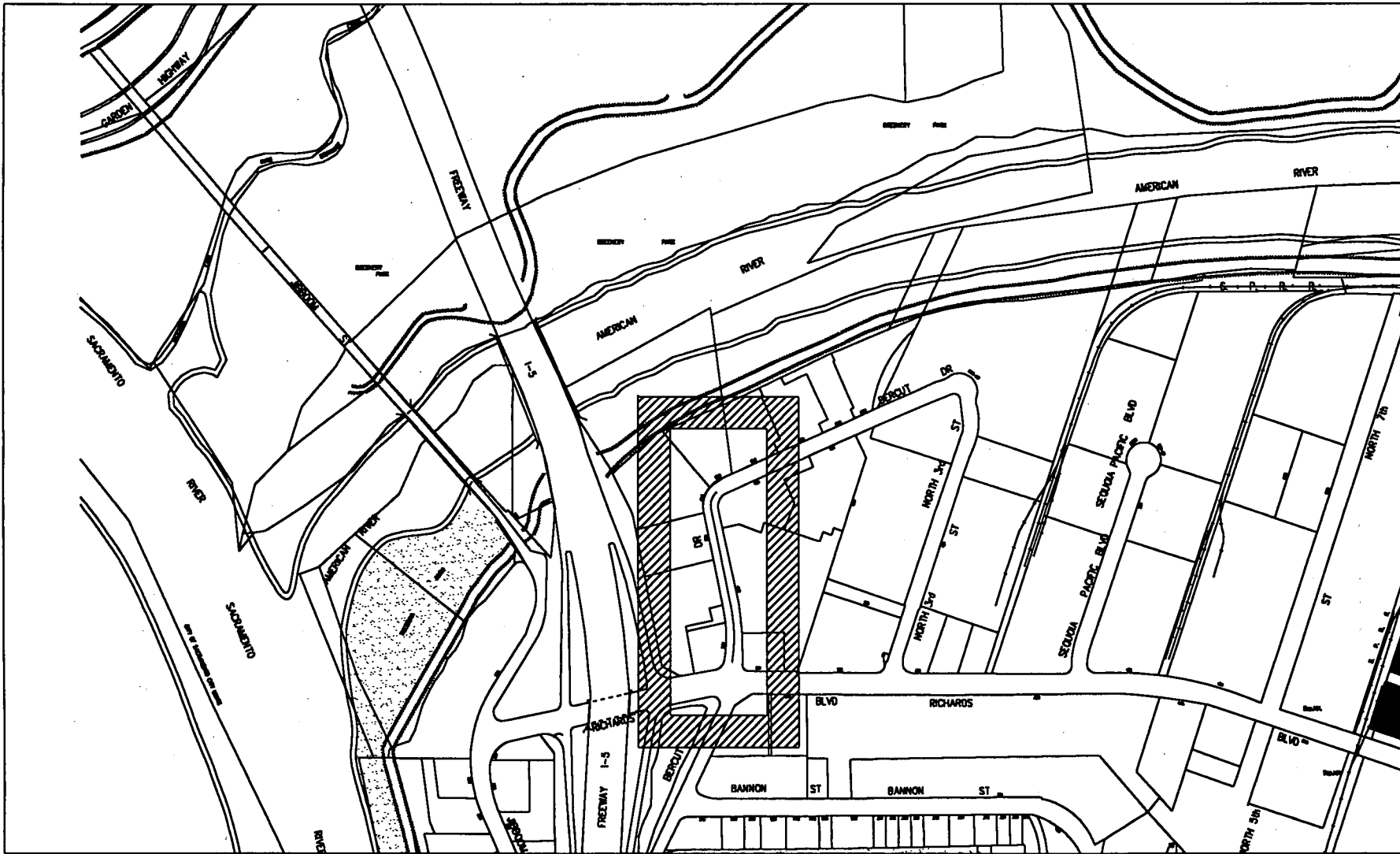
