SUBJECT: SUMP 41 RECONSTRUCTION (PN:WC06) - CONTRACT AWARD

**LOCATION/COUNCIL DISTRICT**

Rio Lane in the Piedmont Area; Council District No. 4.

**SUMMARY**

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the transfer of funds and award of the contract to Scrimsher and Mineni Construction, Inc., the low bidder, in the amount of \$568,629.

**BACKGROUND**

The existing Sump 41 is located in the rear yard of the residence at 989 Piedmont Drive, has a single pump and an undersized wet well. The pump station has inadequate capacity, requires excessive maintenance, and contributes to flooding in the streets in the Piedmont area. On June 23, 1992, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on July 15, 1992. The bids received were:

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$517,000. The estimated completion date is February 1993.

### FINANCIAL DATA

The total project cost, including administration, design, construction, consultants, and inspection is \$825,000. The Sump 41 Reconstruction Project (WC06) has an approved budget of \$650,000. The unobligated balance in the project is \$522,792. Additional funds in the amount of \$175,000 are needed to complete the project.

Funding is available in the Stormwater Miscellaneous Improvements Project (WA71). This project is used to fund miscellaneous, unanticipated but necessary improvements to the drainage system. This project has a budget of \$704,500 and an unobligated balance of \$603,257. It is proposed that \$175,000 from this project be made available for the reconstruction of Sump 41. These funds do not have to be restored to the Stormwater Miscellaneous Improvements Project, therefore, this action has no impact upon user rates.


### POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article 58.304 of the City Code concerning award of contracts.


### MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications were sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors. The low bidder listed two (2) subcontractors who are certified WBE firms.
