SUBJECT: Continuation of Compensation and Benefits for Employees in the
General Management Unit

SUMMARY

The existing short-term agreement between the City and the Sacramento City Management Association (SCMA), covering employees in the General Management Unit, expires on January 26, 1985. This expiration date coincides with the beginning of the January 25, 1985 to February 24, 1985 open filing period for a decertification election petition pursuant to Article V of the City Employer-Employee Relations Policy. The SCMA is presently reviewing several options regarding its status as the collective bargaining agent for the General Management Unit. We will report back to the City Council at a later date as to the decision made by SCMA. Approval by the City Council of the attached resolution is necessary to continue the current schedule of compensation and benefits.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the attached resolution in order to continue the current schedule of compensation and benefits for employees in the General Management Unit.
