SUBJECT: Consultant Services Agreement with the American Lung  
Association-Emigrant Trails

SUMMARY

The attached agreement with the American Lung Association in a joint project with the Cleaner Air Partnership of Sacramento will provide for the City's \$47,500 contribution toward a \$100,000 project proposed by the Clean Air Partnership to be conducted between November 8, 1988 and September 15, 1989. The purpose of the project is to further public education on air quality issues.

BACKGROUND

In November of 1987, the City Council adopted a resolution supporting the policy recommendations of the Clean Air Partnership with respect to air quality improvement issues. In April of 1988, the Cleaner Air Partnership of Sacramento, in a joint project with the American Lung Association-Emigrant Trails and the Sacramento Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce, requested funding from the City in the amount of \$50,000 to develop programs and policy recommendations to assist the City in meeting national and state clean air standards in preparation for an air quality plan update.

The overall work program of the attached agreement includes Steering Committee activities of the Cleaner Air Partnership, development of a public education plan, and design of a plan to reduce non-home to work trips.

FINANCIAL

The overall work effort of the Cleaner Air Partnership for 1988/89 will be co-funded by the City (\$47,500), the Sierra Foundation (\$25,000), and the Air Pollution Control District of Sacramento (\$27,500).


In May and June of this year, the City Council's Budget and Finance Committee held public hearings on the proposed budget. The Committee recommended an amendment to the proposed budget to include carryover of \$50,000 to the FY88-89 Public Works budget to fund this project. This amendment was adopted by the City Council on June 28, 1988.

The contribution was reduced by \$2,500 in August 1988 because funding was provided as a contribution to the Institute for Resource Management to host the Clean Air Futures Conference. Therefore, the agreement has been written for \$47,500. Funds are available in the Transportation Division operating budget (101-310-3128-4258.)

RECOMMENDATION




