

RESOLUTION No.171

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 12, 1940

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONDEMNATION OF PROPERTY FOR ACQUISITION BY CITY

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND AND DETERMINED BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the public interest and necessity require the
acquisition by said City of certain real property in the City
of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, described
as follows:

Beginning at the Northeasterly corner of Lot No. 29 of
Block 58 of Subdivision "E" of Oak Park, (as the same is
shown on the official plat thereof, recorded in the office
of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, March 7,
1896, in Book A of Maps, Map No. 31), said point
being further described as being located South 53°
23.87' West, 36.41 feet from a monument marking the
intersection of the original center line of Sacramento
Boulevard and 5th Avenue, (West of Sacramento Boule-
vard), of the City of Sacramento; thence from the
point of beginning South 18°, 32.46' West, 6.45 feet
along the easterly line of said Lot No. 29 to a
point; thence North 38°, 35.87' West, 12.00 feet along a
line parallel to and distant 56.00 feet southwesterly
from the new center line of said Sacramento
Boulevard to a point on the Southerly line of said 5th
Avenue, (West of Sacramento Boulevard); thence South 71°
06.81' East, 10.08 feet along the southerly line of
said 5th Avenue, (West of Sacramento Boulevard), to the
point of beginning and containing 33 square feet, more
or less.


for the purpose of obtaining area necessary for the widening
