

ORDINANCE NO. 1593, FOURTH SERIES.

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO HAVE THE WORK OF DRILLING A WELL IN THE AREA KNOWN AS "COLONIAL ACRES" DONE IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to have the work of installing a well approximately 250 feet deep in the area known as "COLONIAL ACRES" done without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter.

That this procedure was recommended and approved by the City Manager, after having received a report from the Superintendent of the Water Department stating that the City's interest would be best served by authorizing the City Manager to contract for this work in the open market without first calling for bids.


That the City Manager is further authorized to enter into a contract for this work in a sum of not to exceed \$5900.00 and payment for said work to be made out of BUDGET 301C (WATER DEPARTMENT).

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the immediate necessity of having this well drilled at an early date, in a satisfactory manner, in order to provide water service for residents within the Colonial Acres area.
