RESOLUTION ACCEPTING QUITCLAIM DEED

WHEREAS, ETHEL B. PANERO has made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Quitclaim Deed dated the 14th day of July, 1936, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, bounded and particularly described as follows:

A fraction of the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 16, Township 8 North, Range 5 East, N. D. E. & M., described as:

Being bounded on the south by the south line of said Northeast quarter of Section 16; bounded on the east by the west line of a County road running north and south, known as 65th Street, in said City of Sacramento; bounded on the north by the south line of a tract of land now or formerly owned by John Cordano and the south line of Lot 17 "White-Boething Tract," (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California); on the west by the easterly line of 63rd Street; and containing 8 acres, more or less;


And being situated at the northwest corner of 5th Avenue and 65th Street
