

ORDINANCE NO. 1569, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING CERTAIN AVENUE, WAY AND ALLEYS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the following avenue, way and alleys in the City of Sacramento described as follows:

First Avenue from the Westerly line of 24th Street to the Westerly Boundary of Highland Park (as the same is shown on the official Plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder); Sloat Way from the Westerly line of 24th Street to the Westerly Boundary of said Highland Park; Alley in Block bounded by Burnett Way and First Avenue, 24th Street and Westerly Boundary of said Highland Park; Alley in Block bounded by First Avenue and Sloat Way, 24th Street and Westerly Boundary of said Highland Park; Alley in Block bounded by First Avenue and Sloat Way, 24th and 25th Streets,

are hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that said portion of said avenue, way and alleys herein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.


