

ORDINANCE NO. 1123, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE PROPERTY FROM THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase from the Surplus Property Division of the United States Government the following:


- (a) 25-2½ ton trucks;
- (b) 1-6 ton truck,

without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby made an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that these trucks are needed immediately by the City, are available from the Surplus Property Division of the United States Government, and January 30, 1946, is the final date for the City of Sacramento to exercise its priority to make such purchase.
