

RESOLUTION APPROVING REPORT AND FIXING TIME AND
PLACE OF HEARING THEREON NO. 2493

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sacramento did heretofore, and on the 5th day of June, 1942, order the preparation by the City Engineer of the City of Sacramento of a Report under the provisions of the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931," and covering certain proposed improvements on "F" Street, from the westerly boundary of "Ellis Tract" (as the same is shown on the official map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California), produced northerly, to the easterly line of 53rd Street, produced northerly,

in the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, said Report has been duly completed and presented to this City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:




