

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-701

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 25, 2007

APPROVING A CONTRACT: WILLIAM LAND PARK JOGGING PATH (LW72)

BACKGROUND:

- A. William Land Park is a 166.5-acre regional park located in the Land Park Neighborhood.
- B. The William Land Park Jogging Path Master Plan was reviewed and approved by City Council in Resolution 2002-496 on July 18, 2002.
- C. The William Land Park Jogging Path has been developed in phases over the past five years; the project master plan and Phase 1 of construction were approved by Council on July 18, 2002. Phase 2 of the project was approved as a change order to the original contract on March 6, 2003. This phase (Phase 3) of construction will complete the jogging path master plan.
- D. City Code Chapter 3.60 identifies the general guidelines for completing contracts for public projects and procedures for bidding and issuing contracts over \$100,000.
- E. The formal bid process for the William Land Park Jogging Path project has been completed based on the qualifications set forth by the City.
- F. Pursuant to City Code Section 3.60.020, it was determined that American Landscape & Concrete was the responsible, low bidder with a total bid of \$154,634.
- G. There are sufficient funds in LW72 to award this contract.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract specifications for William Land Park Jogging Path (LW72) are approved and the contract is awarded to American Landscape & Concrete for an amount not to exceed \$154,634.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract with American Landscape & Concrete for William Land Park Jogging Path (LW72) for an amount not to exceed \$154,634.
