HONORABLE MEMBERS IN SESSION:

SUBJECT: Establishing the Agency's Contribution under the
Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act.

SUMMARY:

The attached resolutions establish the amount of the Agency's contribution for health insurance. This adjustment is necessitated by the recent labor agreement with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, (AFSCME), Local 146, and the benefit adjustment for non-represented employees as approved by the Redevelopment Agency and the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento on June 25, 1981.

BACKGROUND:

The Redevelopment Agency and the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento are eligible to contract with the Public Employees' Retirement System for health insurance coverage under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act. Government Code Section 22825.6 provides that a local agency contracting under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act shall establish the Agency contribution by resolution of the governing board of the Agency.

The recent labor agreement and benefit adjustment for non-represented employees changed the Agency contribution for health insurance as follows:
