1. Portable Signs Enforcement (A-Frame, Etc.)

DISCUSSION:

Mac Mailes, Director of Planning and Community Development, presented a brief slide show and description of where A-Frame signs are illegally placed throughout the City. Mac summarized the report and recommended that no changes be made to the existing sign ordinance, and that the sign ordinance be enforced as adopted. He also discussed what affect these signs might have on the handicapped and the liability the City could incur.

Jim Henley, Executive Director of the Museum and History Division, informed the committee of his intent to draft a sign ordinance for Old Sacramento which would exclude A-Frame signs. He concurred with the proposal to eliminate the signs.

REPORT(S) BACK:

Staff was directed to make another special effort to get a written response from the Chamber of Commerce, Mid Town, Old Sacramento, and the Downtown Merchants. Staff will report back to the committee in 30 days if responses are received. Otherwise, staff will report directly to the City Council with recommendations.
