

ORDINANCE NO. 1175 FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 5 and 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1066, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 10, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES AND WAGES OF ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE DETERMINATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 1026, 1031, 1045, 1047, 1052, 1053 and 1065, RESPECTIVELY, OF THE FOURTH SERIES, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

SECTION 9: Section 5 of Ordinance No. 1066, Fourth Series, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5: Demotion - Effect upon Rate of Compensation.

Upon the demotion of any employee from a position of a higher classification to a position of a lower classification, the employee so demoted shall receive a salary or wage set out in the salary step of the classification of the position demoted to, which corresponds to the total number of years of service of such employee with the City.

Upon the reclassification of the title of a position from a higher classification to a lower classification, the employee occupying the position at the time of such reclassification shall continue to receive the same salary or wage while occupying such position of said lower classification. Upon the future vacancy of such position so reclassified, any new employee appointed to the position shall receive the salary or wage set out in the salary step of the classification as provided for in this Ordinance.

The operation of this section shall in no instance have the effect of giving to such employees an immediate salary increase.
