## **Description/Analysis**

**Issue:** At the City Council meeting of January 18, 2011, the City Council approved a community participation process; on February 8, 2011, the City Council approved Resolution 2011-068, which established the 2011 Sacramento Redistricting Citizens Advisory Committee. This report provides an update to the proposed schedule for the redistricting process and provides a demonstration of the software tool to be used for drawing redistricting maps.

**Policy Considerations:** The 2010 Census data was provided to the City on March 8, 2011. The City Charter – Section 24 of Article III – requires that the City Council adopt new Council district boundaries within six months after release of the United States census data.

### **Environmental Considerations:**

**California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA):** The subject of this report is not, in itself, a project. The subject of this report does not involve a project which requires compliance with the CEQA, inasmuch as it does not involve an activity which may cause a direct or indirect change in the environment (Public Resources Code Section 21065).

**Sustainability Considerations:** None.

**Commission/Committee Action:** Not applicable.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** The proposed schedule for the redistricting process complies with the City Charter and maximizes the opportunity for broad civic engagement consistent with the City's culture of open and transparent government.

**Financial Considerations:** On January 18, 2011, the City Council approved Resolution 2011-033, which established a multi-year CIP (I07000700) for redistricting activities and allocated \$160,000 of General Funds from the Administrative Contingency to the effort. The redistricting software tool was purchased from these funds.

**Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD):** Not applicable.

**Background**

At its January 18, 2011, meeting, the City Council approved a community participation process for redistricting. Staff was then directed to report back with additional information regarding the possible formation of a citizens advisory committee. Staff returned to Council on February 1, 2011, when Council approved the formation of a citizens advisory committee.

On February 8, 2011, the City Council approved Resolution 2011-068, which established the Sacramento Redistricting Citizens Advisory Committee (SRCAC). The Resolution defines the purpose, composition, selection, and timeframe of the SRCAC.

On March 8, 2011, the U.S. Census Bureau released local-level 2010 Census population counts for Sacramento. The data provides population, race, and Hispanic origin by Census Block.

The Census data will be integrated into the redistricting software that City staff is developing for the public's use. It is anticipated that the software tools will be completed and available to the public at the end of March.

The City Charter provides that the Council shall commence and complete the redistricting process within six months of the release of the Census redistricting data. The data released on March 8<sup>th</sup> is approximately three weeks earlier than was anticipated and moves forward the overall schedule by three weeks.

Below is a high level summary of the adjusted scheduled key dates:

- March 8<sup>th</sup>: Data is released by Census
- April – May: Census Data, Tools, and Community Outreach/Training available for Community
- April – June: Citizens Advisory Committee Meets
- June – August: Council Considers Redistricting Recommendations, Comments, and Proposals
- September 6<sup>th</sup>: Council adopts final ordinance for new boundaries

The detailed calendar and timetable for the redistricting process are provided as Attachments 2 and 3.
