

Sacramento, California,

August 4, 1932.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in regular session on the above date at five-forty o'clock P. M. in the office of the Board, Room 106 City Hall, President Weisman presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Deise and Weisman.

ABSENT : Commissioner Chenu.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Upon motion of Commissioner Deise, seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and unanimously carried, the Civil Service Board accepted the evidence that John Frei has furnished as sufficient evidence to prove that he is one and the same person as Ulric Thomas, and that he is entitled to veterans preference as defined under Section 45 of the City Charter. The Secretary was instructed to make the proper notation on the records.

An application for leave of absence was presented by F. Kunz, an employee in the Fire Department, stating that on account of his extended illness he was unable to as yet perform his duties. It was properly moved by Commissioner Deise, seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and unanimously carried that he be granted a leave of absence for ninety days.

A letter of thanks was received by the Board from Mrs. Leroy E. Deise for the lovely bouquet of flowers which were sent her while confined to the hospital during her recent illness. The President expressed his appreciation and hoped that Mrs. Deise was again enjoying good health.

It was properly moved by Commissioner Deise, seconded by Commissioner Weisman, and unanimously carried that the Secretary represent the City of Sacramento at the coming Civil Service Assembly which is to be held in San Francisco on August 18th, 19th, and 20th.

No further business appearing before the Board, they stood adjourned at 6:05 o'clock P. M. to meet again at the call of the Chair.
