

RESOLUTION No. 184
RESOLUTION RE-ESTABLISHING LINES
 Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

June 6, 1929.

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that the portions of Lots 17 and 18, Block 53, of "Wm. J. Landers' Subdivision "B," (as the same is shown on the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California,) being located on the north side of 5th Avenue, between 33rd and 34th Streets, which lie southerly of a line drawn parallel and forty (40) feet distant, measured at right angles, from a line described as follows: beginning at a point which is the intersection of the center line of 5th Avenue and the westerly line of 33rd Street; thence on a curve of radius 118.49 feet, whose chord bears south, 65° 49' east, 98.15 feet, to a point; be, and the same are, hereby dedicated for street purposes, and to be regarded as an additional width on 5th Avenue, between 33rd and 34th Streets;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the curb line on the northerly side of 5th Avenue, between 33rd and 34th Streets, be, and the same is, hereby ordered changed and re-established to be on a line twenty-seven (27) feet northerly and parallel to a line described as follows: beginning at a point which is the intersection of the center line of 5th Avenue and the westerly line of 33rd Street; thence on a curve of radius 118.49 feet, whose chord bears south, 65° 49' east, 98.15 feet, to a point.
