SUBJECT: Animal Control Center Replacement (PN:GA06) - Resolution Approving Negative Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project be approved and the report be forwarded to the full City Council for approval of the Negative Declaration.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the Animal Control Center replacement would not have a significant adverse effect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On September 2, 1988, the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On September 3, 1988, Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.


The existing animal control facility is scheduled for demolition with the development of the Docks area along the Sacramento River and a new facility must be completed before that occurs.

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
RECOMMENDATION
