

ORDINANCE NO. 1531, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE MATERIALS AND CONTRACT FOR LABOR AND EQUIPMENT TO PERFORM THE SERVICE OF APPLYING A REINFORCED GUNITE COVERING ONE AND ONE-HALF INCHES THICK TO THE SLOPES OF THE TWELFTH STREET UNDERPASS, IN THE OPEN MARKET, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase materials and contract for the performance of services and the use of equipment, in the open market, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Sec 251 of the City Charter, for the purpose of applying a one and one-half inch thick coat of reinforced gunite covering to the slopes of the 12th Street Underpass in Sacramento, California, for the sum of not to exceed \$3,200.00.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of immediately completing the work of applying a reinforced gunite covering to the slopes of 12th Street for the safe use of the 12th Street Underpass.
