

ORDINANCE NO. 1601, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE CERTAIN ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS FOR LIGHTING AND FOUR (4) CASH REGISTERS FOR THE MUNICIPAL OFF-STREET PARKING LOTS, IN THE OPEN MARKET WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market without advertising for bids, pursuant to the provisions of Section 251 of the City Charter, electrical equipment and materials for lighting the two municipal off-street parking lots, and also four cash registers for use in the operation of said lots.


SECTION 2: That this equipment, material and supplies will cost approximately Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars.


SECTION 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being the necessity of purchasing electrical equipment and supplies for lighting the recently acquired municipal off-street parking lots and also the purchase of four cash registers for said lots, in order to place these lots in operation for off-street parking as soon as possible.
