SUBJECT: Additional Senior Meal Sites

SUMMARY

This report is submitted for your information and files regarding the addition of two senior nutrition sites to the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program (SENP) operations.

BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Area Economic Opportunity Council (SAEOC) discontinued meal service for senior citizens at the George Sim Park Community Center on January 27, 1982. On February 2, 1982, the Area 4 Agency on Aging asked that the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program assume the responsibility for this meal site and re-open the facility immediately to keep the service interruption for this high-needs community at a minimum. The site was re-opened on February 8, 1982, for continued operation under SENP, replacing one of two nutrition sites lost in the Spring of 1981 by SENP. One site was closed after attendance dropped below a cost effective level due to the opening of a meal site by another nutrition program in the nearby Rusch Park. The other site was lost when the Senior Health Day Care Center on Elvas Avenue, in which the site was located, was closed in May 1981.

In efforts to replace the second site and meet contractual meal service levels, the Hellenic Senior Center in the Greenhaven Pocket area, a new Section 8 subsidized housing complex for senior citizens and handicapped persons, has been selected for opening in early March. Residents of this housing complex meet the target population criteria established for federally funded meal programs. The Area 4 Agency on Aging, which must approve the location of any new senior nutrition sites funded under the Older Americans Act, has approved this site for SENP operation.

FINANCIAL DATA

The approved fiscal year 1981-82 Budget for congregate nutrition services is based on the operation of 17 meal sites, which includes the two new sites. The new operating costs for these two new sites for four and five months, respectively, total approximately \$8,000.00, which is available in the approved program budget for 1981-82.

VOTE AND RECOMMENDATION OF COMMISSION

It is anticipated that at its meeting of February 22, 1982, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission will adopt a motion recommending that you take the above mentioned action. In the event they fail to do so, you will be advised prior to your February 23, 1982 meeting.

RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends the Housing receive and file this report.
