

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION No. 2749

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

MARCH 25TH, 1949

NOTICE OF HEARING OBJECTIONS to the Abandonment of
Certain Real Property for Park Purposes.

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation,
acquired by purchase on December 23, 1929, for a valuable
consideration, all of those certain parcels or lots of real
property situate and being in the City of Sacramento, County of
Sacramento, State of California, particularly described as follows:

Lots eight (8) and fifteen (15) as shown on
the official "Plat of Golf View Tract", recorded
in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento
County, March 9, 1909, in Book 9 of Maps,
Map No. 34,

and according to the terms of the Resolution of the Council
accepting the same, it did so for the purpose of laying out
and constructing a park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation,
acquired by purchase on January 27, 1930, for a valuable con-
sideration, all of those certain parcels or lots of real property
situate and being in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento,
State of California, particularly described as follows:

Lots nine (9) and Fourteen (14) as shown on the
official "Plat of Golf View Tract", recorded in
the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento
County, April 9, 1909, in Book 9 of Maps, Map
No. 34,

and according to the terms of the Resolution of the Council
accepting the same, it did so for the purpose of laying out and
constructing a park; and

WHEREAS, the above described parcels of real property are no longer suitable or necessary for the use as originally contemplated by the City when purchased, and application has been made to the City for the purchase of these properties; and

WHEREAS the above described realty has never been used by the public for park purposes and has never been actually designated by the City on any map or other designation as a park and has not been used by the City, or any other person, for such purpose, and that no consideration has been paid therefor, except by said municipal corporation; and

WHEREAS, the said real property hereinabove referred to was fully paid for with sums of money drawn from the General Fund of the City of Sacramento, and no public funds whatsoever have been expended to improve or locate said parcels of real property, or any part thereof, as a park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation, is desirous of selling and disposing of said real property, and good cause appearing therefor,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That pursuant to the provisions of the Act No. 6374, entitled "THE MUNICIPAL PARK ABANDONMENT LAW OF 1939", it is ordered that Friday, the 29th day of April, 1949, at the hour of eight (8) o'clock P.M., of said day, in the Council Chamber of the City of Sacramento, at 9th and Eye Streets, in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, be, and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place where any person interested may appear and present objections, if any, they have,


why the Council should not order the above described real property abandoned for park purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this RESOLUTION in the Sacramento Union, a daily newspaper, as required by Law, at least once a week for three (3) successive weeks prior to the date of hearing, and that notice thereof shall also be conspicuously posted along the boundaries of said property not less than 100 feet apart and containing not less than four (4) notices in all.
