SUMMARY

Attached are tabulations of sealed proposals received by the City Clerk for furnishing equipment in accordance with specifications adopted by the City Council and recommendation of bid award for Bid No. 1582-A, Shallow River Patrol Vessel, to be used by the Police Department.



BACKGROUND

Specifications for Bid No. 1582-A were adopted by the City Council on December 15, 1992 and bids were called for by the City Clerk on January 6, 1993.

The following is a summary of the recommendation for contract award:

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The State of California Department of Boating and Waterways has contracted with the City of Sacramento to grant 75% of the price of the patrol boat. The balance of the funds required will come from the Fleet Management Vehicle Replacement Fund.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

These recommendations are consistent with the requirements for competitive bidding as detailed in Chapter 57 of the Sacramento City Code.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS

For Bid No. 1582-A, the Request for Bid (RFB) was sent to eight vendors, one of which was a WBE firm. Copies of the RFB were also sent to the Minority Business Exchange and the Sacramento Minority Business Development Center. As a condition of the State grant, the RFB incorporated the State of California M/W/DVBE goals and "good faith efforts" requirements. Bids were received from three vendors, one of which is a Cal-Trans certified WBE. While the vendor recommended for award is not an M/WBE firm, the vendor complied with the "good faith efforts" as required in the RFB.
