

ORDINANCE NO. 1594, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE IN THE OPEN MARKET, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 251 OF THE CITY CHARTER, 55000 CUBIC YARDS OF SURPLUS DIRT FOR THE "J" STREET SUBWAY AND UNDERPASS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to purchase in the open market, without first advertising for bids, pursuant to Section 251 of the City Charter, 55000 CUBIC YARDS OF SURPLUS DIRT for the "J" Street Subway and Underpass. Payment for said surplus dirt to be out of the Bond Fund.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately such emergency being the immediate necessity of acquiring 55000 cubic yards of surplus dirt for the purpose of building up a stockpile of surplus dirt for use in the construction of the "J" Street Subway and Underpass.
