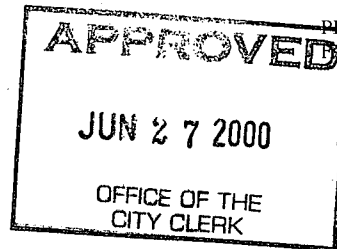

SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ANNEXING A PORTION OF 42nd STREET TO THE U.C.D. MEDICAL CENTER RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

42nd Street, from Folsom Boulevard south for 250 feet. Council District 3.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to annex 42nd Street to the U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit area.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends annexation of 42nd Street from Folsom Boulevard south for 250 feet to the U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit parking area (Exhibit A). Regulating parking on this street will relieve the parking congestion and make it easier for residents to park near their homes.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit area was established in April 1980.
- A neighborhood children's park has generated increased parking congestion on this residential street. Residents from outside of the area drive and park their vehicle, in the neighborhood, when utilizing this park.
- Residents directly across from the park submitted a petition requesting to annex this portion of 42nd Street into the residential permit parking area.
- All non-resident parking will be prohibited on the residential side of the street.
- Visitors to the park will still be able to park on the park side of the street.
- Residents and their guests will be exempt from the parking time limits when the proper permit is displayed.
- A letter was sent to all of the residents that may be impacted by the parking regulation, which outlined the request and solicited comments.
- There was no opposition to the proposed parking restriction.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$200 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking & Animal Care Services operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.





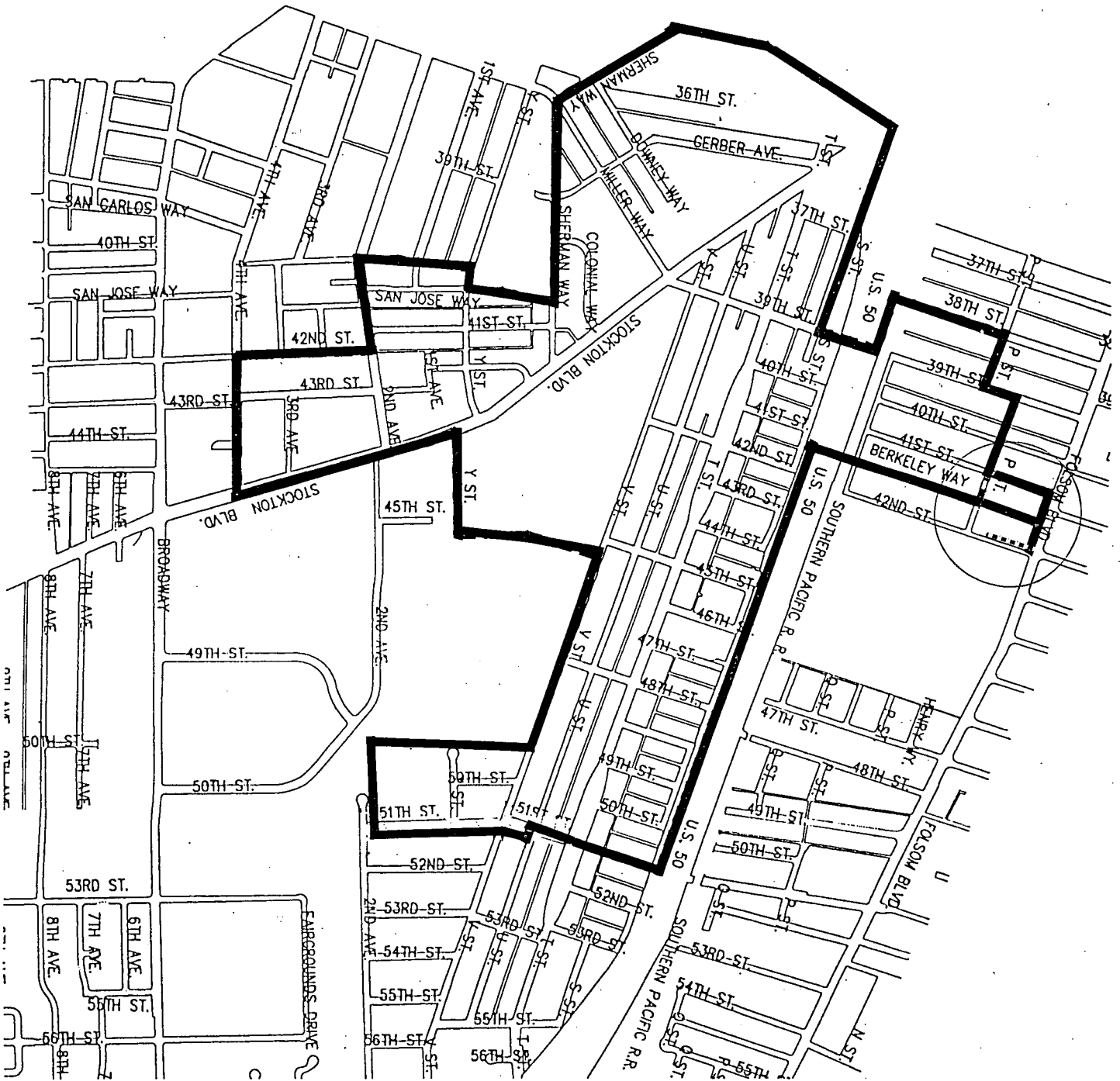
