SUBJECT: RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITS ON A PORTION OF N STREET

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

5800 block of N Street. Council District 3.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution establishing parking time limits on a portion of N Street.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends establishing two-hour parking time limits on the 5800 block of N Street. (Exhibit A). Establishing parking regulations on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by students and faculty from a nearby school.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Residents on the 5800 block of N street submitted a petition requesting to limit parking to a maximum of two hours between of the hours of 7am and 3pm.
- Residents understand that the parking regulations will apply to them and their guests as well as other parkers.
- Residents have adequate off-street parking.
- The school also has adequate parking for faculty, staff, and visitors.
- A letter was sent to all residents that will be impacted by the change which outlined the request and asked for comments.
- There was no opposition to the proposal.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended modified parking regulation is estimated to be \$500 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking & Animal Care Services operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITS ON A PORTION OF N STREET

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10.36.100, of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed by the Parking Manager, giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in a business district or on streets designated by resolution during the days and hours indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following street shall be regulated by two-hour parking time limits from 7am to 3pm except Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.

- N Street, both sides from 58th Street east to the end of the street.
