

The Office of Public Safety Accountability (OPSA) received a total of 10 community generated complaints with 12 known allegations regarding Sacramento Police Department (SPD) employees during the month of December. Below is a breakdown of the complaints received.

The complaints received by members of the community and are broken down by month based on the date received or closed, not the date of occurrence. There are two categories: formal and informal.

Formal complaints are assigned to an Internal Affairs Division (IAD) investigator. If the allegation is in fact true, there would be a violation of policy and therefore potential discipline could be imposed. The race of the complainant and officer will be shared.

Informal complaints are ones that were handled at a lower level with only a preliminary investigation being needed to determine either there was no violation of policy or even if the allegation was true, it would not violate a policy. The race of the complaint, not the officer will be shared.
