

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2009-454**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

### **APPROVING THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT FOR HEAVY DUTY FLEET TIRES**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Department of General Services, Fleet Management Division has ongoing requirements to purchase supplies through contracts of other governmental jurisdictions including the State of California and Sacramento County. The City has an opportunity to obtain lower pricing for these items through volume purchasing.
- B. In accordance with City Code 3.56.240, the City Manager may, by cooperative purchasing agreements approved by City Council, purchase supplies through contracts of other governmental jurisdictions without separate competitive bidding, where it is advantageous to the City.
- C. Using the existing cooperative purchasing agreement available from the County of Sacramento to purchase heavy duty fleet tires for City vehicles and equipment is advantageous to the City as the agreement meets the needs of the City's fleet specifications and will result in cost and time savings.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. County of Sacramento contract number WA00024636 with Morgan Tire Company of Sacramento is hereby approved for the purchase of heavy duty fleet tires in an amount not to exceed \$2,045,000 through April 28, 2012, or until the contract is no longer available for use.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the necessary purchase orders totaling the amount specified above provided that sufficient funds are available in the budget adopted for the applicable fiscal year(s).


