

## RESOLUTION No. 865

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

October 28, 1949

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SACRAMENTO:

THAT FARMERS RICE GROWERS COOPERATIVE be granted a revocable permit to extend their spur track 19 feet in order to permit the spotting of a car at the grain unloading opening in the sidewalk near the south end of their plant.

That the description of the said proposed extension of existing spur track along Front Street between "O" and "P" Streets to serve the Farmers Rice Growers Cooperative is as follows, to-wit:

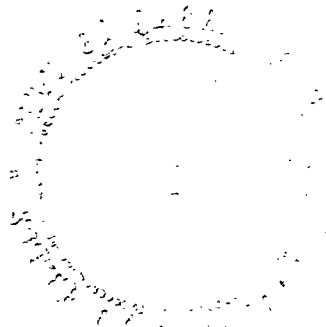
Beginning at a point in the center line of an existing spur in Front Street, which point is 152-ft., more or less, northerly from the center line of "P" Street, said point of beginning also being 20-ft., more or less, westerly from the easterly property line of Front Street; thence from said point of beginning 19-ft. southerly and parallel to said mentioned easterly property line of Front Street.

Foregoing permit is granted in accordance with application and blueprint filed October 26, 1949, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 237 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento, at no expense whatsoever to said City of Sacramento.
