

Resolution of Intention No. 2110

2110

Pursuant to the authority of an Act of the Legislature of the State of California, known as the "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7th, 1911, and the several Acts amendatory thereof.

It is hereby resolved that it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Sacramento to order the following street work to be done, to-wit:

The improvement of the following in the City of Sacramento:

"P" Street, from the easterly line of 7th Street to the westerly line of 12th Street (excepting therefrom the intersections of 8th Street, 10th Street and 11th Street); by removing and disposing of all surplus and refuse material; constructing concrete curb and gutter; reconstructing existing manholes and catch basins by placing curbs and covers to grade; placing street monuments; grading; filling in places below sub-grade with crushed rock; and resurfacing the existing macadam pavement with an asphaltic concrete wearing surface with a seal coat.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the detailed plans therefor adopted by the said City Council and now on file in the office of the City Engineer, and also in accordance with the "Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers", heretofore adopted by said City Council.

Concrete curb and gutter shall conform to Cut No. 6 of said Specifications.

Existing macadam pavement shall be scarified and prepared otherwise as set forth in Subdivision "A" of Section 25 of said Specifications.

Wearing surface to be asphaltic concrete four (4) inches in thickness and shall conform to provisions of Subdivision "B" of Section 25 of said Specifications.

Seal Coat shall conform to provisions of Subdivision "C" of Section 22 of said Specifications.

Notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments and bear interest at the rate of seven (7) per cent per annum will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915", the last installment of which bonds shall mature nine (9) years from the second day of July next succeeding ten (10) months from their date.

All persons objecting to said work, are required to file their objections in writing in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Sacramento, as required by law, and notice is hereby given, to all persons interested that on the **5th** day of **August**, 1926, at **8** o'clock P. M., in the Council Chamber of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, in the City Hall, on "I" Street, between 9th and 10th Streets, in said City, any and all persons having any objections to the proposed work and improvement may appear before said City Council and show cause why the proposed work and improvement shall not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.

And the City Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution twice in the **Sacramento Union**, a daily newspaper, as required by law.
