Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That it is the sense of the City Council and City Administration of the City of Sacramento that, when the Central Valley Project is in position to deliver power, the said City purchase its power requirements from said Project and work out a plan whereby such power may be distributed to the industries and inhabitants of said City; and which said power required will be upwards of eighty million kilowatt hours, annually.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Water Project Authority c/o Executive Officer, 401 Public Works Building, Sacramento, California.


