

ORDINANCE NO. 1132, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: The following street in the City of Sacramento at present named Seventh Street shall be known and designated as CAROLYN WAY, which shall be the official name thereof, to-wit:


"That portion of Seventh Street which lies between Swanston Drive and Robertson Way"

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; the emergency being that much confusion now arises concerning the location of addresses on this street due to the break caused in Seventh Street by Southside Park and other developments.
