Following communications were received and ordered filed:

Protest of Sacramento Orphanage and Children's Home against making commercial zone at corner of 12th and Franklin Boulevard.

Report of Realty Board stating that it would be impossible to make appraisal of property fronting Capitol Park on 9th street and N Street without indicating that all existing commercial property should remain as zoned.

Communication from Eighth street Taxpayers Association requesting improvement North B Street.

Request of Chairman of City Planning Committee of California Real Estate Association requesting copy of Sacramento City Planning Commission Bulletin.

Request of East Portal Civic Club requesting copy of semi-monthly bulletins.

Communication from Ellen L. MacFarland requesting that property at Southwest corner of Stockton Boulevard and Second Avenue remain as zoned at the present time and made parallel with Stockton Boulevard.

Communication from Albert Givan requesting that Southeast Corner of Dolores Way and J Street be classified as commercial.

Report from City Assessor Mier appraising value of property fronting Capitol Park along 9th street on N Street between 9th and 10th streets.
