

ORDINANCE NO. 1150, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 29, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated, out of the sum heretofore appropriated for REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS in Budget No. 44 "DIVISION OF WASTE REMOVAL - GARBAGE COLLECTION", the following sums:

The sum of \$3000.00 to REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS in Budget No. 39 DIVISION OF WASTE REMOVAL - STREET CLEANING;


The sum of \$1500.00 to REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS in Budget No. 55 PARK DEPARTMENT;

The sum of \$1500.00 to REPAIRS AND REPLACEMENTS in Budget No. 61 CORPORATION YARD.


SECTION 2: this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, being an ordinance appropriating money.
