SUBJECT: Annexation of 24th Street from 4th Avenue to Marshall Way to the D.M.V. Residential Permit Parking Area

SUMMARY

This report recommends the annexation to the D.M.V. Residential Permit Parking Area of 24th Street from 4th Avenue to Marshall Way.

BACKGROUND

Residents of 24th Street, from 4th Avenue to Marshall Way, have submitted a petition representing 77% of the resident addresses requesting implementation of Residential Permit Parking. This street is adjacent to the Department of Motor Vehicles and has experienced parking problems as a result of the Residential Permit Parking Program in the area. This action is in accordance with Section 25.186 for annexation of streets adjacent to existing Residential Permit Parking Areas.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost of this annexation will be \$400 for posting signs in the area. The increase in annual operating costs will be minimal. Sufficient funds will be available for these costs in the 1982-83 Traffic Engineering Operating Budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached Resolution amending Resolution 81-136 be adopted for modifying the D.M.V. Residential Permit Parking Area as shown herein.
