SUBJECT: Increase Revenues to the Capital Grants Fund, Appropriate Funds from Capital Grants and Modification of Capital Improvements Program to construct Undulations on V Street

SUMMARY

The U.C. Medical Center has offered to fund construction of undulations on V Street between 39th and 49th Streets. It is recommended that the offer be accepted and the 1988-89 Capital Improvement Program be amended. This item was heard before the Budget & Finance Committee on December 6, 1988.

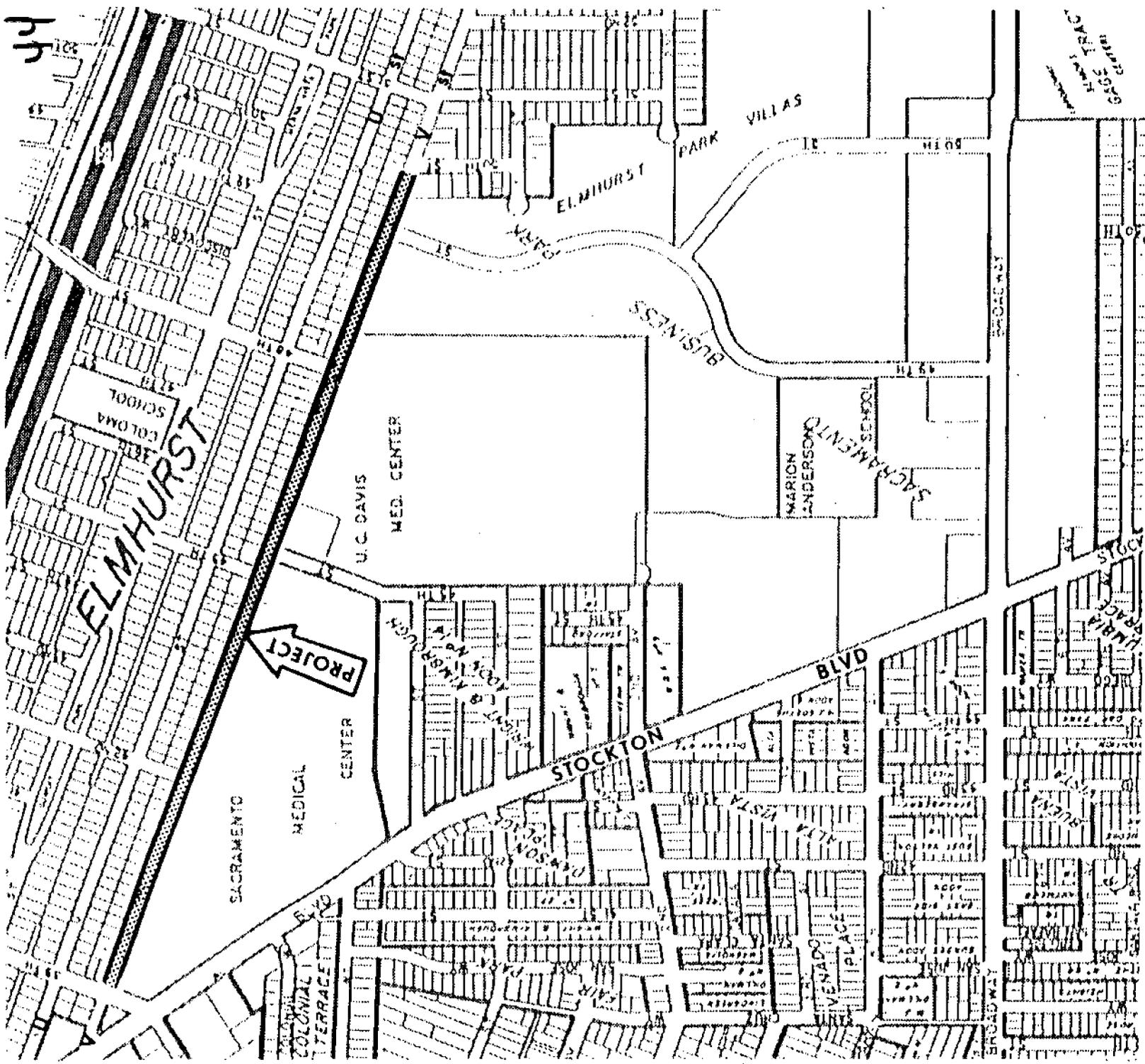

Subject: Increase Revenues to the Capital Grants Fund,
Appropriation of funds from Capital Grants and
Modification of Capital Improvements Program to construct
Undulations on V Street

SUMMARY

The U.C. Medical Center has offered to fund construction of undulations on V Street between 39th and 49th Streets. Four (4) sets of undulations are proposed. The estimated cost is \$4,850.00. It is recommended that this offer be accepted and that Capital Grants Revenues be increased and the 1988-89 Capital Improvement Program be amended to reflect this project.

BACKGROUND

V Street between 39th Street and 49th Street is approximately 3500 feet in length (see Exhibit A). Typically a street of this length would qualify for undulations, however due to the non-residential nature of the property on the south side of the street (U.C. Medical Center) this location is not on our current priority list. The City does receive complaints regarding speeding on this street and the U.C. Medical Center has offered to pay for the construction of undulations.

Staff supports the Medical Center's offer and recommends including this segment in the next City undulation contract which should be advertised in February or March of 1989. By using this approach we will obtain better per unit costs and maximize the Medical Center's funds.

It is estimated that four (4) sets of undulations would be required for the segment of V Street. An agreement to fund these undulations has been executed by the Medical Center. Council authorization to exercise the agreement on behalf of the City is requested.

FINANCIAL

It is estimated that the total cost to construct four (4) sets of undulations is \$4,850.00 to be paid by the University of California, Medical Center.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached resolution be approved to:

1. Amend the 1988-89 Capital Improvement Program by increasing the revenue to the Capital Grants Fund by \$4,850.00.
2. Amend the 1988-89 Capital Improvement Program by creating a new project to construct undulations on V Street between 39th Street and 49th Street.
3. Appropriating \$4,850.00 from the Capital Grants Fund to the V Street Undulation Program.
4. Authorize the City Manger and City Clerk to execute all agreements necessary to secure funds from the U.C. Medical Center to construct four (4) sets of undulations.

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Sacramento:

1. That amending the Capital Grants Fund (248-500-XXXX) by increasing the revenues to the fund by \$4,850.00 is hereby approved.
2. That the 1988-89 Capital Improvements Program is hereby amended to include construction of Undulations on V Street.
3. That an appropriation of \$4850 from the Capital Grants Fund to the V Street Undulation project in the following manner is hereby approved.
 - \$250 to Labor Costs (248-500-XXXX-4880)
 - \$150 to Reimbursement Benefits (248-500-XXXX-4881)
 - \$330 to Indirect Costs (248-500-XXXX-4831)
 - \$4120 to Construction (248-500-XXXX-4820)
4. That the City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to execute all agreements necessary to secure payment in the amount of \$4,850.00 from U.C. Medical Center is hereby approved.

CONTRACT

The parties to this agreement are the City of Sacramento (hereinafter referred to as "the City") and U. C. Davis Medical Center (hereinafter referred to as "Med Center").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Med Center desires to have 4 sets of undulations placed on V Street between 39th Street and 49th Street in Sacramento, California, and

WHEREAS, City recognizes the desirability and utility of such undulations, and

WHEREAS, the City is not planning to place undulations a said location in the immediate future.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. The City hereby agrees to install 4 sets of undulations on V Street between 39th Street and 49th Street conforming to the currently used undulations specifications in the City and integrated into and made a part of the public street system of the City.

2. One set of undulations will be placed on V Street between 39th Street and the emergency room driveway to Med Center and the remaining 3 sets of undulations shall be appropriately spaced and located on V Street between the emergency room driveway of Med Center and 49th Street.

3. In consideration for constructing these undulations and in accordance with the terms of this contract, Med Center agrees to pay the City the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$4,850), payable on execution of this contract.

4. The City shall using its own forces, design, plan and inspect the work of construction of said undulations, and the City shall, by using a competitive bid system, obtain a contractor to construct said undulations all for an estimated amount not to exceed Four Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$4,850).

5. Med Center shall have no obligation to maintain or in any other way be responsible for said undulations other than the construction cost thereof contained in this agreement.
