SUBJECT: Revocable Encroachment Permit - 545 West Silver Eagle Road

SUMMARY

Moss Land Company has applied for a Revocable Encroachment Permit for the purpose of constructing concrete curbing at back of sidewalk for planting area at 545 West Silver Eagle Road. The Director of Public Works recommends that the Permit be granted.

BACKGROUND

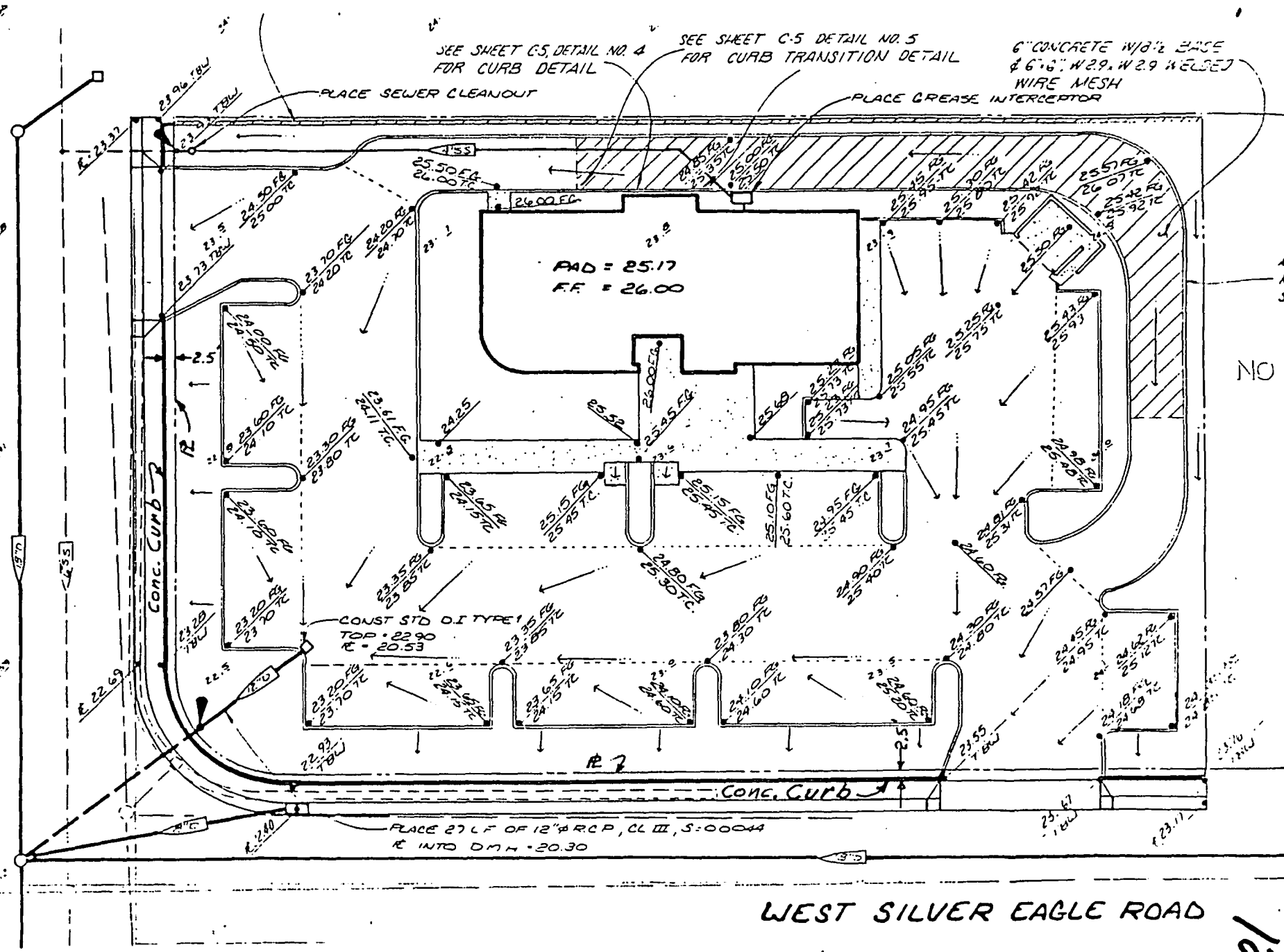
