RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO,
ADOPTING BUDGET AND APPROVING FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM
OF AGREEMENT FOR EXPENDITURE OF 1/4 CENT GAS TAX ALLOCATED
FOR STATE HIGHWAYS.

WHEREAS, the State of California, through its Department
of Public Works, Division of Highways, has presented a fifth
supplemental memorandum of agreement in accordance with a project
statement submitted by the City for expenditure of the 1/4 cent
gas tax for the 1939-41 biennium allocated for State Highways
in the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heard read said agreement in
full and is familiar with the contents thereof;

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City
of Sacramento that said agreement for expenditure of the 1/4
cent gas tax allocated for State highways be and the same is
hereby approved, and the Acting City Manager and Assistant City
Engineer are directed to sign the same on behalf of said City.
