Subject: Appointment of Self-Supplied Industry Representative to the Sacramento Groundwater Authority (SGA)

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the City Council appoint Terry Jewell as the Self Supplied Industry representative from the Sunrise Recreation and Park District to the Sacramento Groundwater Authority. Mr. Jewell, District Administrator, has worked for the Sunrise Recreation and Park District since 1991.

Summary:

The Joint Powers Agreement that created the Sacramento Groundwater Authority (Authority) authorized the City Council to appoint representatives from adjacent water districts, water companies, and self-supplied pumpers. Jeff Dubchansky was the previous representative for the self-supplied industry. The Sunrise Recreation and Park District have requested that the City appoint the representative to a four-year term (Attachment 1).

Committee/Commission Action: None.

Background Information:

- On August 11, 1998, the City Council approved a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA), which created the Sacramento North Area Groundwater Management Authority.

- Signatories to the JPA are the City, the County of Sacramento, and the Cities of Citrus Heights and Folsom.
- The JPA delegates to the Authority the powers to manage the groundwater basin consistent with the Water Forum Agreement and establishes the membership of the Authority to include:
 - A member of the Board or designee for each private purveyor
 - One representative of agricultural interest in the North Area
 - One member of self-supplied groundwater users in the North Area
- The JPA requires that the City Council appoint representatives from the City, Arden Cordova Water Company, California-American Water Company, Del Paso Manor Water District, the Natomas Central Mutual Water Company, the Sacramento Suburban Water District, and self-supplied users.
- The City Council previously appointed Jeff Dubchansky as the self-supplied industry representative to the Sacramento Groundwater Authority.

Financial Considerations:

The proposed action will have no financial impact to the City.

Environmental Considerations:


In compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City certified a negative declaration regarding the JPA on August 11, 1998.

Policy Considerations:

The proposed action is consistent with the JPA approved by City Council.
