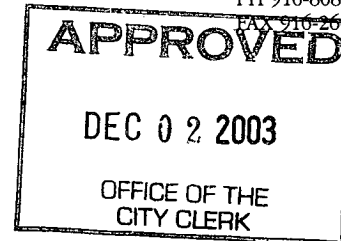

**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION MODIFYING PARKING TIME LIMITS ON A PORTION OF Q STREET IN THE STATE CAPITOL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

- Q Street, north side, from 15<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> Streets. Council District 4.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution modifying parking time limits on Q Street between 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Streets in the State Capitol residential permit parking area.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends modifying the parking time limits on a portion of Q Street between 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Streets (Attachment A). Modifying the parking regulations will help to relieve parking congestion, and provide residents with additional street parking. It is estimated that it will cost \$500 for the installation of regulatory signs.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- All parking on the north side of Q Street between 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> Streets is currently prohibited.
- Residents have been having difficulty parking near their homes especially during the days with street cleaning restrictions and have requested that parking be allowed on the north side of the street adjacent to Fremont Park.
- Traffic Engineering was contacted and the need to have the parking removed no longer exists.
- Parking is regulated on the other streets adjacent to the park with 10-hour parking meters. Staff is proposing that 10-hour parking meters also be installed on the north side of Q Street.
- Residents and their guests will be exempt from paying the meter when the proper permit is displayed.
- A letter outlining the proposal and a return card was distributed to residents and owners of the properties that will be impacted by the parking change.
- There was no opposition to the proposal.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulations is estimated to be \$1,500 for the installation of the regulatory signs and parking meter posts. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Planning and Building Department, Environmental Services Division has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


This recommendation is consistent with the City's Strategic Plan and the goal of the City Council to enhance and preserve the neighborhoods.

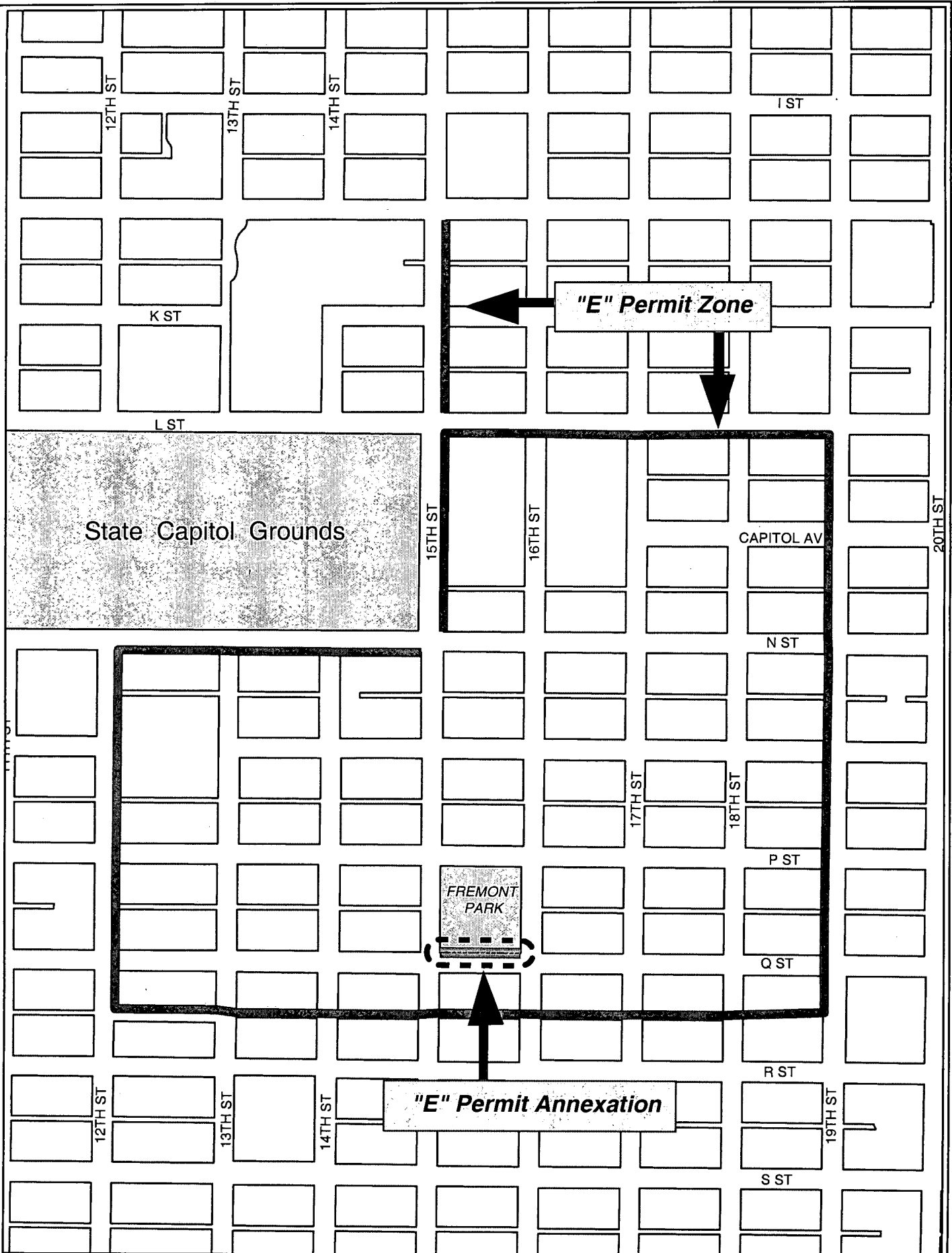

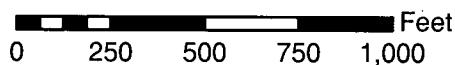

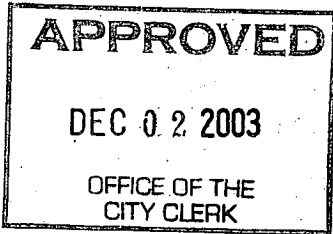
